



HUNTERCOMBE GOLF CLUB GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS

As a visitor, we hope you enjoy your day at Huntercombe. To help you, we suggest the following:

- On arrival, please obtain the main entrance security number from a member of staff.
- Societies should book in with the Steward in the Clubhouse.
- Green fee visitors should sign the register and pay in the Pro's Shop before playing.
- Visitors should always use the Changing Rooms. Please do not bring golf clubs into the Clubhouse.
- Dress code in the Clubhouse: Smart casual up to 6.00pm. After that, for Men, jackets and ties are required.
- Dress code on the Course: jeans are not permitted. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in at all times - tee shirts are not permitted. For Men, knee-length tailored shorts are only allowed if accompanied by long socks.
- The use of mobile phones is not permitted in the Clubhouse or on the Course.
- All Societies and Visitors must start from the 1st tee, using the Yellow tees only.
- Forms of play: Singles, Foursomes (or Three-balls only with permission from the Secretary). Fourballs, Greensomes or Medal play are not permitted at any time.
- Please give way to faster-moving players.
- Please keep up with the players in front - Huntercombe is well known for its fast rate of play, and a round of golf should normally take no longer than 3 ½ hours.
- Please respect our green staff and their instructions when they are working on the Course.
